



- Q I want information about living in Japan
- A We have prepared a "Welcome Kit" containing information about living in Japan for foreign residents and counselling on daily life, in English, Spanish and Chinese. (the days on which speakers of these languages are available is not fixed)
- Q I am looking for Japanese class and an Interpreter/Translator.
- A We provide information on Japanese language classes in Tsuzuki Ward. We listen to what you need help with and connect you with volunteer interpreter.
- Q I want to consult about my child arriving from my country to Japan
- A We can consult about Japanese language support or school studying support or high school entrance exams for international students.
